

The Guadalajara City Council, through the council of the edile committee on health, sports, and youth attention of the Guadalajara City Council and the decentralized public organization of the municipal public administration, known as the municipal Sports council of Guadalajara COMUDE Organizing committee with the endorsement of world athletics WA, the Mexican federation of athletics association FMAA and the association of international marathons and distance races AIMS invites individuals to participate in the 2023 Guadalajara international marathon hydrated by electronic.

1 organising committee.

The organising committee will adjust this call for participation to the current regulation of WA, the norms and provisions issued by FMAA and AIM, as well as the authorities of the government of the state of Jalisco and the Guadalajara City Council.

The information will be released through the official communication channels of the organizing committee.

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2 regulations.

The x international marathon Guadalajara 2023 hydrated by electrolit, is an urban food race of 42,195 metres, certified and approved by the WA, FMAA and AIMS, all Mexican and foreign individuals who meet the requirements indicated by the regulations established by the WA as well as the regulation issued by the FMAA, the organizing committee, and those express in this call will not be able to participate and the registration fee will not be refunded.

At the time of registration, athletes must provide accurate information that will be considered as a sworn statement regarding the information provided, ensure that they are in optional health conditions, and authorize the exoneration of legal responsibility and the privacy notice of the X international marathon Guadalajara 2023 hydrated by electronic.

Athletes must be at least 18 years old on the day of the test, you must sign the liability waiver in order to receive your number.

3. Start, Route and Finish. The course, Urban and on asphalt, is certified by WA, FMAA, AIMS, marked with a line indicates all the kilometres according to WA regulation. The event is included in the WA international calendar and has the distinction of role athletics label.

The departure will be on Sunday, November 5th 2023 in the downtown area of Guadalajara, Jalisco, Mexico. The 2023 international Guadalajara marathon, hydrated by electrolit, will

determine departure zones in order to establish warm up areas, improve comfort, and ensure the safety of all athletes 6 20 AM, Paralympics categories zone1 Z1

6:30 AM, elite athletes zone2 Z2

And qualified athletes Zone3 Z3.

6:35 AM, conventional athletes Zone 4 onwards Z 4.

The athletes will have access to the wardrobe service, which will open one hour before the start and they must retrieve their belongings from the wardrobe by 2:00 PM. The organizing committee is not responsible for any damage, theft, or total or partial loss.

Water isotonic drinks, Vaseline, sponges, and showers will be placed along the route according to the rules and regulation of the current WA competition and technical regulations.

only vehicles designated by the organizing committee will be authorized to follow the race. it is strictly forbidden to follow the runners on motorcycles, bicycles, rollerblades, or any other vehicle. local police and member of the organizing committee will remove them from the circuit to prevent accidents.

the security is strategy along the marathon route will be implemented from 6:00 AM to 1:30 PM at the finish line.

any athlete who exceeds the time indicated on the rear guard table must do so obligatorily abandon the test and/or get on the assigned vehicle, failure to do so will release the organizing committee from any responsibility.

The finish line will be in the city centre of Guadalajara, with the official maximum time to finish the race being at 13:00 hours, after this time, any athlete loses the right to receive their medal and time registration.

4. Categories and Marks.

4.1. Elite athletes.

These are individuals who have established records in endorsed by the WA to compete in formal events.

Additionally, the organizing committee will consider athletes who request and provide information about a race endorsed by the WA or FMAA, where they have achieved a marathon time in either 2023 or 2022, For female athletes, the time should be equal to or less than 03:15:00 minutes, and for male athletes, the time should be equal to or less than 02:30:00 minutes.

4.2. Qualify Athletes.

Participants who wish to enter zone 3, established for qualified athletes, must be classified as participants and meet the requirements established in the call for the X international marathon 2023, sponsored by Electrolit, in addition to complying with the following provisions. Request to the organizing committee to be considered a qualified athlete for this marathon via e-mail: atleta.clasificado@comudeguadalajara.gob.mx starting from Monday, October 16th to Monday, October 30th, 2023, please provide your full name, official participant number, branch and category.

Attach to the aforementioned e-mail a time certificate with your name, in which you have achieved a time equal to or below the established limits in the following table for classified athletes. It should have been obtained in a race endorsed by WA or FMAA, in the years 2023 or 2022. table or qualified athletes female time limit category Melton limit

** the participant must present a certificate of time specifying that they achieved a placement within the top five positions of the category they registered for, from a race endorsed by WA or FMAA, in the years 2023 or 2022.

- Only the participant authorized by the organizing committee will be able to access zone 3.

On the other hand, they will be able to enter the other blocks starting from zone 4, which will depend exclusively on their time of arrival.

4.3 Para/Athletes participants.

Must attach a certified document or medical diagnosis that confirms their professional ID and the professional stamp that issued it, proving the disability. wheelchair athletics must participate with a helmet and carry their official number on the back of their wheelchair in a visible place.

Total blind and visually impaired athletes must run blindfolded and tethered to their respective guides from the start, during, and until the end of the race, with the possibility of changing to a maximum of two guides. This change can only be made at kilometers 1,20 or 30 of the route, which must be informed at the moment of registration. The decision to participate with one or two guides must be confirmed to the judges on the day of the event, in the warm-up area. Both athletes must wear their respective official number and bib, located on the chest.

Athletes with bilateral hearing impairment and a decibel equal to or greater than 55 in their ears must wear their runner's number and the "deaf" bib assigned by the organizing committee on their chest.

5. Registrations.

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°Central offices of the municipal sports council of Guadalajara –COMUDE-, from 9:00 to 19:00 located at #100 Nevado de Toluca Street, between Av. De los Maestros and Siete Colinas street, Col. Independencia (neighborhood).

°Recreational route-VIA RecreActiva- module, at the Revolucion park on the days when the program is carried out from 9:00 to 13:00.

°International Marathon Sports Expo Guadalajara 2023, subject to availability.

There is limited space for 4'000 participants and each registration will have a recovery fee of:

°\$290.00 (two hundred and ninety pesos) per person once this summons is published until Sunday, October 1, 2023.

°\$390.00 (three hundred and ninety pesos) per person from Monday October 2nd to Saturday November, 4th, 2023 or until reaching capacity.

At the time of making your payment, an additional commission for bank charges may be added according to the platform used by the participant.

No recovery fee for the following athletes:

° For 100 athletes aged 60 and above, on the day of the event, from the metropolitan area of Guadalajara presenting a printed application and a copy at the offices of the Municipal Sports Council of Guadalajara, including a copy of the INAPAM, INE or valid passport. Follow-up will be done via email adulto.mayor@comudeguadalajara.gob.mx

° For 100 athletes aged 60 and above, on the day of the event, from inside the state and the Mexican Republic, sending a request before Friday, October 13th 2023, addressed to the General Director of the Municipal Sports Council of Guadalajara, attaching a copy of the INAPAM, INE or valid passport. Follow-up will be done via email adulto.mayor@comudeguadalajara.gob.mx

- ° For 100 paralympic athletes, categories: I athletes on wheelchairs, J athletes with total blindness and visual impairment, and K athletes with bilateral hearing impairment and a decible equal or greater than 55 in both ears, requesting in writing before Saturday, November 4th, 2023, addressed to the General Director of the Municipal Sports Council of Guadalajara and verifying permanent disability through a certificate or medical diagnosis signed and stamped by the professional who issued it. Follow-up will be conducted through the email paratleta@comudeguadalajara.gob.mx
- **For 150 elite athletes** requesting registration before Saturday, November 4th, 2023, and demonstrate having times endorsed by the WA to compete in the tag events, as well as all athletes authorized by the FMMAA. Follow-up will be conducted through the email atleta.elite@comudeguadalajara.gob.mx
- 2'000 courtesy passes will be granted to the organizing committee of the GAY GAMES 2023 GUADALAJARA.
- To all athletes who are assigned as special guests to the event by the organizing committee.

They will be allowed to transfer their registration to another person with an additional cost of 50% of the current registration fee, with a deadline of Saturday, November 4th, 2023.

The organizing committee is not responsible for the reliability, truthfulness, and/or suitability of registrations made through third parties, nor does it assume any obligation regarding availability and/o Price.

6. Numbers delivery.

Numbers will be delivered exclusively at the international maratón sport expo Guadalajara 2023. On Friday, November 3rd, and Saturday, November 4th, 2023, from 10:00 to 18:00. The venue will be informed in a timely manner through official media channels.

Requirements:

The official number will only be delivered to the participant, as this process is personal. They must show the confirmation QR code received through email at the corresponding module, as well as a valid official photo ID. This information can be presented in printed or digital format.

Each properly registered athlete will receive the following:

- ° Official number with chip;
- ° A commemorative piece of clothing from event; and
- ° Items from our official sponsors.

Please note:

- ° Numbers will not be delivered to those who do not meet the requirements set by the organizing committee.
- ° Numbers will not be delivered on the day of the event.

7. Awarding.

Athletes with an official competition number who complete the certified and approved route will be awarded a commemorative medal.

The total economic prize in Mexican Pesos will be 1'700'000.00 (One million seven hundred thousand pesos). It will be presented on Sunday 5th, 2023, through a nominative check redeemable at a banking institution once the official results are confirmed until 14:00. Athletes who do not collect their prize on the day of the event must go to the central offices of the Municipal Sports Council of Guadalajara, located at #100 Nevado de Toluca Street, between Av. De los Maestros and Siete Colinas street, Col. Independencia (neighborhood) within the Independence Sports Complex, between 9:00 to 14:00, the deadline for collection is Friday, December 8th, 2023. Valid photographic identification must be presented.
